<u>Art</u>

2D Studio: Experience painting, drawing, and a variety of two-dimensional art projects.

3D Studio: Experience sculpture, ceramics, pottery, and a variety of three-dimensional art projects.

Digital Art: Create computer art projects.

Photography: Learn about the elements of photography, take and edit photos using photoshop.

Crafts: Experience a wide variety of crafts -bracelet making, sewing, and jewelry making.



Print Shop: Be part of running Davenport School of the Arts' professional printshop. Class designs posters and a variety of print materials. Also creates and prints programs for drama productions.



<u>Dance</u>

Dance Elective course is a combination of Tap, Choreography, and Ultimate Dance.

Tap: Learn how to tap dance, no previous tap experience required. Students dress out in a leotard and Jazz pants every day. DSA will provide tap shoes for this elective.

Dance Choreography: Develop pieces of choreography through literature, dance elements and improvisation. Learn the 7 step method of choreography. Students dress out in plain black leotard and black leggings.

Ultimate Dance: The Ultimate Dance experience is a fun class that incorporates stretching (flexibility), body strengthening



work outs, Jazz and Contemporary choreography, Yoga, Nutrition, Injury prevention, small and large Student Choreography projects and performance opportunities. Performing is NOT a requirement. It will be offered for those who wish to perform. All elective students will be required to dress out in Black Leotard and Yoga pants everyday with hair in a ponytail and dancing in bare feet.

<u>Drama</u>

Exploratory Theater/Play Production: Acting and theatre technique

Musical Theater ****** All in one class - acting, singing, movement and staging. Includes an end of year performance.

Script Writing/Improvisation: Experience improv acting and learn how to write play scripts.



<u>Music</u>

Band** Learn to play the trumpet, trombone, French horn, tuba, or saxophone and be part of a music group. Instrument rental or purchase required. Participate in music concerts at school.

Rock Band** Audition required. Performing and recording group open to vocalists, guitar, bass guitar, drums, wind and string instruments. Instrument rental or purchase may or may not be



required, depending on the instrument. Participate in music concerts at school.

Percussion: Learn proper drumming techniques on a wide variety of instruments such as drum set, world drums, mallets-including xylophone and vibes, timpani, cymbals and much more. Experience drumming in various styles with all types of beats. Participate in music concerts at school.

Steel Drums** Learn how to play steel drums, several different types of steel drums are available to play. Participate in music concerts at school.

Guitar: Have you ever wanted to learn to play guitar? This is the class for you! Participate in music concerts at school.

Piano** Learn to place piano and participate in end of year recital.

Handbells** Learn how to play handbells (if you have never heard of handbells please look it up – they are super cool and make beautiful music). Participate in music concerts at school.

Chorus** Experience what your voice can do through singing. Participate in music concerts at school.

Orchestra** Learn to play the violin, viola, bass, or cello. Instrument rental or purchase required. Participate in music concerts at school.
